-:-: BY AND BETWEEN, CITY OF HOPKINS AND E.M. WILHOIT, OIL CO .-:-:-

-:-: THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into this 12th day of Nov,1914. by and between the City of Hopkins, Nodaway County Missouri, of the First Part, and E.M. Wilhoit, of the second part, Witnesseth-;

That in consideration of the sum of Eighteen (18) Dollars per annum payable in advance, the said First party gives and grants to said second party the right and privilege of using the following real-estate, "to-wit;

Begining at the Railroad right_of_way, directly West of the North End of Block, Twelve, (12) in said City, Thence, East to the East line of said Block Twelve, (12) in said City, Thence, North Thirty (30) feet, Thence West to the Railroad right of_way, Thence in a South West-erly direction along said Right_of_way to begining, for the purpose of erecting thereon storage tanks for illuminating, oils, gasoline and lubricating oils, and selling such oils and gasoline therefrom.
