

ORDINANCE NO. (74)

A Bill for an Ordinance, to levy taxes for the City of Hopkins MO for the Year 1917.

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen, of the City of Hopkins, MO as follows:

There is hereby levied for the Year 1917, a tax Twenty-Five cents, on the One Hundred Dollars, Valuation on all taxable property in the City of Hopkins, for general purposes,- and

There is hereby levied for the Year 1917, a tax of Eighty-Five cents on the One Hundred Dollars, valuation, on all taxable property in the City of Hopkins, for the purpose of paying the interest, and bonds, for building the City Water works: and

There is hereby levied for the Year 1917, a tax of Twenty-Five cents on the One Hundred Dollars, valuation, on all taxable property in the City of Hopkins, for the purpose of lightening the City of Hopkins,: and

There is hereby levied for the Year 1917, a tax of Twenty-Five cents on the One Hundred Dollars, valuation on all taxable property, in the City of Hopkins, for the purpose of paying the interest and Bonds, for the improvement, of the Crossings, bridges, and Streets, in the City of Hopkins.

This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
